

WHAT'S THE TIME?

No. of Scouts: 6

Equipment: Sheet of paper and a Sharpie

Scout one is lying asleep on ground or across a couple of chairs. Scouts two and three walk onstage.

Scout Two: We need to be back to camp before it's too late. What do you think the time is?

Scout Three: I don't know. Let's wake this girl up and ask her. (Shakes scout one.)

Scout One: What is it?

Scout Two: Could you tell us the time please?

Scout One: You woke me up for that! (Looks at watch.) It's half past seven.

Scout Three: Thank you. We need to rush. Bye! (Scouts two and three walk offstage as four and five walk onstage as scout one lies back down.)

Scout Four: We need to be back to the scout hut before Skip gets too worried. What do you think the time is?

Scout Five: I don't know. Let's wake this girl up and ask her. (Shakes scout one.)

Scout One: NOT AGAIN! What is it?

Scout Four: Could you tell us the time please?

Scout One: You woke me up for that! UNBELIEVABLE! (Looks at watch.) It's eight o'clock.

Scout Five: Thank you. We need to rush. Bye! (Scouts four and five walk offstage. Scout one writes, "I DO NOT HAVE THE TIME" and lies back down. Scout one could read out the words as she writes them down - actually or mime.)

Scout Six (coming onstage): Oh dear, this poor young person needs help. (Wakes them up.)

I'm sorry that you don't have the time. Just to let you know it's half past eight. Would you like me to get you a watch?

Scout One (holding out her arm): Aaarrggghhhh!
